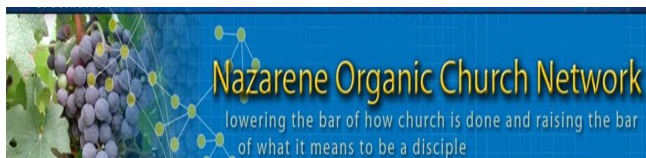


What would happen if we taught every Christian to be a missionary and viewed every neighborhood as a mission field and every church became a training center sending out Organic Church Planting Missionaries?

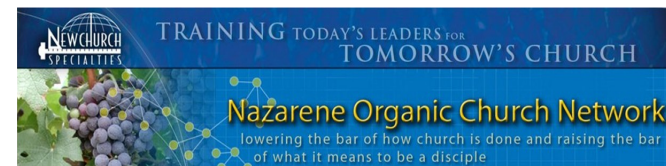

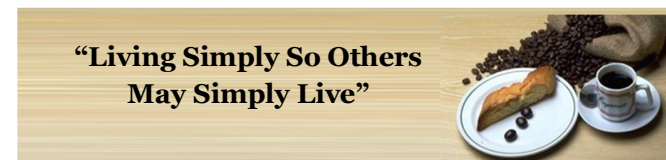

Understanding the Organic Church

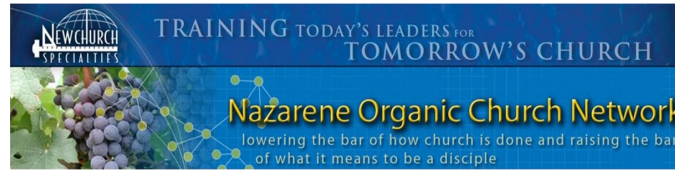


This New Church Specialties one day seminar assists districts with an understanding of the Organic Church movement
